



THOMPSON SPEEDWAY MOTORSPORTS PARK 2021 FAN INFORMATION SHEET

Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park is excited to see fans return to the grandstands for the 2021 season for oval track racing. American Canadian Tour and Pro All Star Series officials have formed a partnership with Thompson to promote six oval events – starting with the annual Icebreaker, April 10-11.

Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park will run at limited 50% capacity for the indefinite future due to restrictions from the state of Connecticut due to COVID-19. This is for the safety of all. Advance tickets are currently for sale for Icebreaker only at this time.

Below is some additional important information for fans to know about returning to Thompson during COVID-19:

WHAT CAN I BRING WITH ME?

- Small coolers with snacks, drinks and ice inside are allowed. Attendants will be asked to open their own coolers and gate personnel will check them.
- Small, personal size bags, like a purse or pocketbook.

WHAT CAN I *NOT* BRING WITH ME?

- No backpacks will be allowed.
- Only clear bags will be allowed for loose items.
- Thompson Speedway can only conduct limited bag checks during the pandemic for the safety of patrons and staff.

SOCIAL DISTANCING IS REQUIRED:

Groups in the grandstands should be limited to just your personal family and those who you traveled to the track with.

Groups must be socially distanced from other groups by at least six feet. If there is a space in between two groups that is only six feet, please do not try to stuff into it. Always keep the safety of yourself and others in mind when at Thompson Speedway.

Lines at the bathrooms, concession stands and gates should have six feet of distance between patrons.

FACE COVERINGS:

- Face coverings are required when entering the facility, walking around the midway, in the bathroom or in any area where there is a constant flow of pedestrians.
- Face coverings are not required once you are seated, socially distanced, in the grandstand area, but are encouraged.
- Face coverings are required while walking through the pit area, but not required when you are in your own pit stall. Please avoid from mingling between pit stalls to keep everyone safe.

IS CAMPING ALLOWED?

- Camping is allowed starting with the Icebreaker event
- All COVID guidelines remain in place for the campgrounds just like they are in the stands
