



Thompson Speedway Face Mask/Covering Policies

As per the Connecticut Executive Orders, Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park will require the use of face masks to begin the 2021 season. Face masks and/or cloth face coverings are required for ALL attendees at the Thompson oval track events.

The state mandate specifies that face masks MUST be worn in all indoor and outdoor public spaces where it is not possible to maintain a social distance of at least six feet from those outside your household or social group. As such, the mandate includes fans, drivers, crew members, staff, officials, and all others who race, watch, or work at Thompson Speedway.

GENERAL ADMISSION

Examples of when general admission attendees must wear face masks or coverings are:

- Checking in at the ticket booth
- Going to the concession stands, merchandise vendors or bathrooms
- Walking around in the grandstand area
- Interacting with others who are outside your household/group etc.
- The only time you do NOT have to wear your face mask is when you are sitting down with the group you came to the track with and are at least 6 feet apart from other groups.

PIT & GARAGE AREA

- Those in the pit & garage area should wear a face covering during the following circumstances:
 - During sign-in at the paddock area
 - Walking around outside their pit area
 - Visiting the concessions or bathrooms
 - Interacting with track staff, members of other teams, etc

- Walking to the assigned bleacher section

The only time those in the pit/garage area do NOT have to wear a face mask is when they are in their own pit area with their own group. Drivers also do not have to wear face masks while they are in their cars.

EXCEPTIONS TO FACE COVERINGS

Patrons do not have to wear face masks in the following situations:

- When they can maintain a physical distance of at least 6 feet from people outside their household/group
- When they are eating or drinking
- If they have a pre-existing medical issue that would be made significantly worse by wearing a mask
- Anyone under the age of two years old
